



# Integration for Milestone XProtect VMS V1.0.0.0

## User Guide

- This manual describes the maximum configuration of the system with the maximum number of functions, including future options. Therefore, not all functions described in this manual may be available in the specific system and/or product configuration you purchased.
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- All wiring diagrams are intended for reference only, the photograph of the PCB(s) are intended for clearer illustration and understanding of the product and may differ from the actual PCB(s).

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# 1. Prerequisites

## 1.1. Software


### 1.1.1. AxTraxPro

- A functioning AxTraxPro Installation version 28.0.2.7 or above
- AxTraxPro Plugin for XProtect installer (“Setup AxTraxPro Integration for Milestone XProtect VMS.exe”).

### 1.1.2. Milestone XProtect Management Client

- Server running Milestone XProtect version 2023R1 or later.
- Compatible XProtect product (see information below)

## 1.2. Licensing

### 1.2.1. AxTraxPro

To find license information:

1. View the AxTraxPro Standard Level.
2. View the AxTraxPro Milestone XProtect Plugin

### 1.2.2. XProtect Access

To find license information:

1. In the Management Application, view the the MIP Plug-ins section.
2. In the Management Client, view the license overview page.

### 1.2.3. Individual doors

To find license information:

1. Open the Access Control system integration properties.
2. Click Door and Associated Cameras.

### 1.2.4. Trial license

- For XProtect Express+, XProtect Professional+, XProtect Corporate, and XProtect Expert products, XProtect Access offers a 30-day trial license for all newly added doors.
- For XProtect Professional and XProtect Express products, XProtect Access offers a 30-day trial license for up to three doors.
- Unlicensed doors stay in your system with the following limitations:
  - you will not be able to view events and status for unlicensed doors.
  - you cannot lock, unlock, or perform other commands on unlicensed doors.

## 2. Installing the AxTraxPro Integration for Milestone XProtect VMS Plugin

1. On the server hosting the Milestone Management server and Milestone Event Server, run the following provided file:  
AxTraxPro Integration for Milestone XProtect VMS.exe
2. Follow the instructions displayed.



During installation, the installer restarts the **Milestone XProtect Event Server Service**.

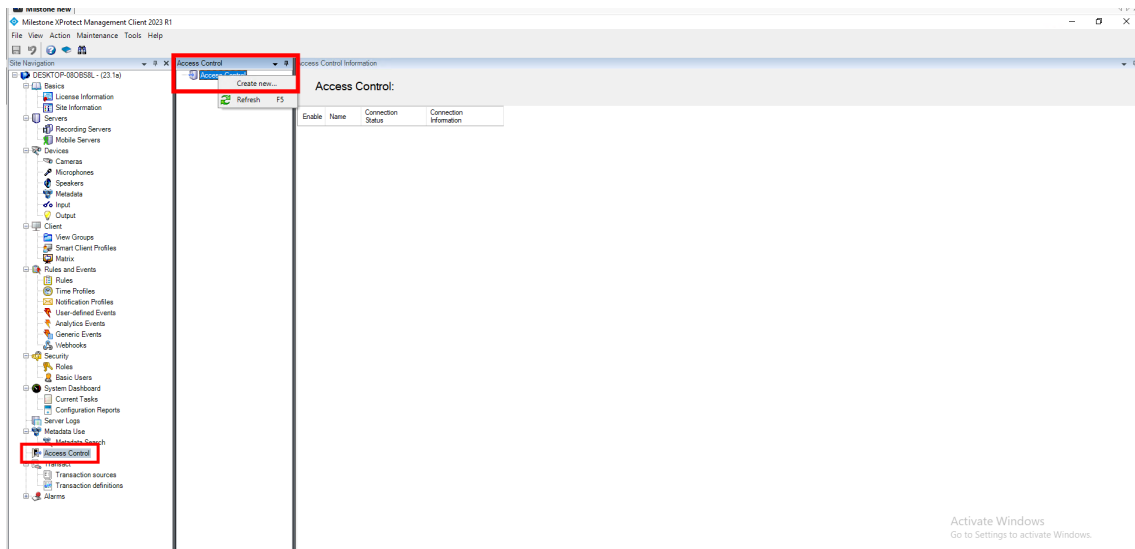
To uninstall the plugin:

1. Stop the Milestone Event Server Service
2. In **Add or remove programs**, uninstall the application.

## 3. Configuring the Milestone XProtect Management Client Access Control System

### 3.1. First Connection

1. In the Milestone XProtect Management Client, click **Access Control**, then in the secondary panel right-click **Access Control** and click **Create new**.



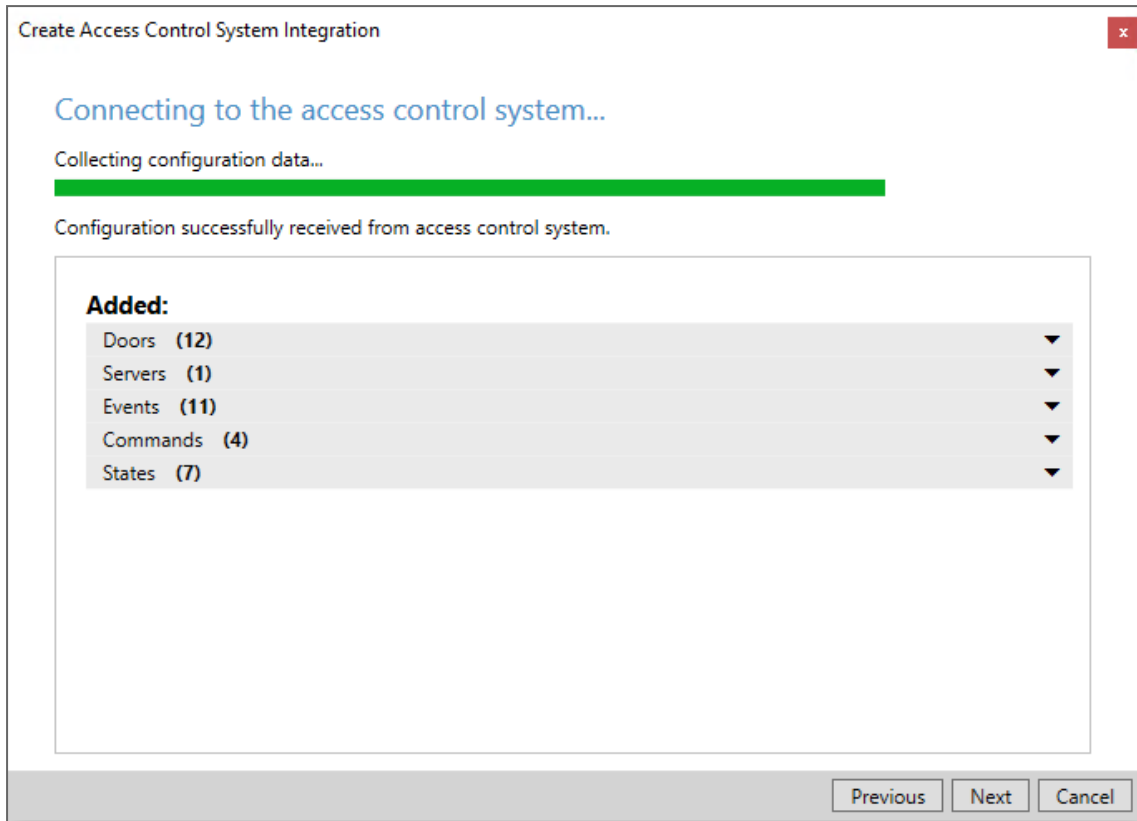
Activate Windows  
Go to Settings to activate Windows.

- In the **Name** field, enter a name for the Integration.

- Click **Integration plug-in** and select **AxTraxPro Integration for Milestone XProtect VMS**.
- Fill in the following fields:
  - Address - IP address of the AxTraxPro server.
  - Server Port - the port used to connect to AxTraxPro Web-Server (default: 3006). See AxTraxPro™ Desktop Client User Guide, section *Configuring the AxTraxPro web server*.
  - Server Identification port - the port used to connect to AxTraxPro Web-Server Identification (default:3000)
- Click **Next**. The plug- connects to the AxTraxPro Server. If configuration retrieval succeeded, you will see a list showing all items used by the access control system.



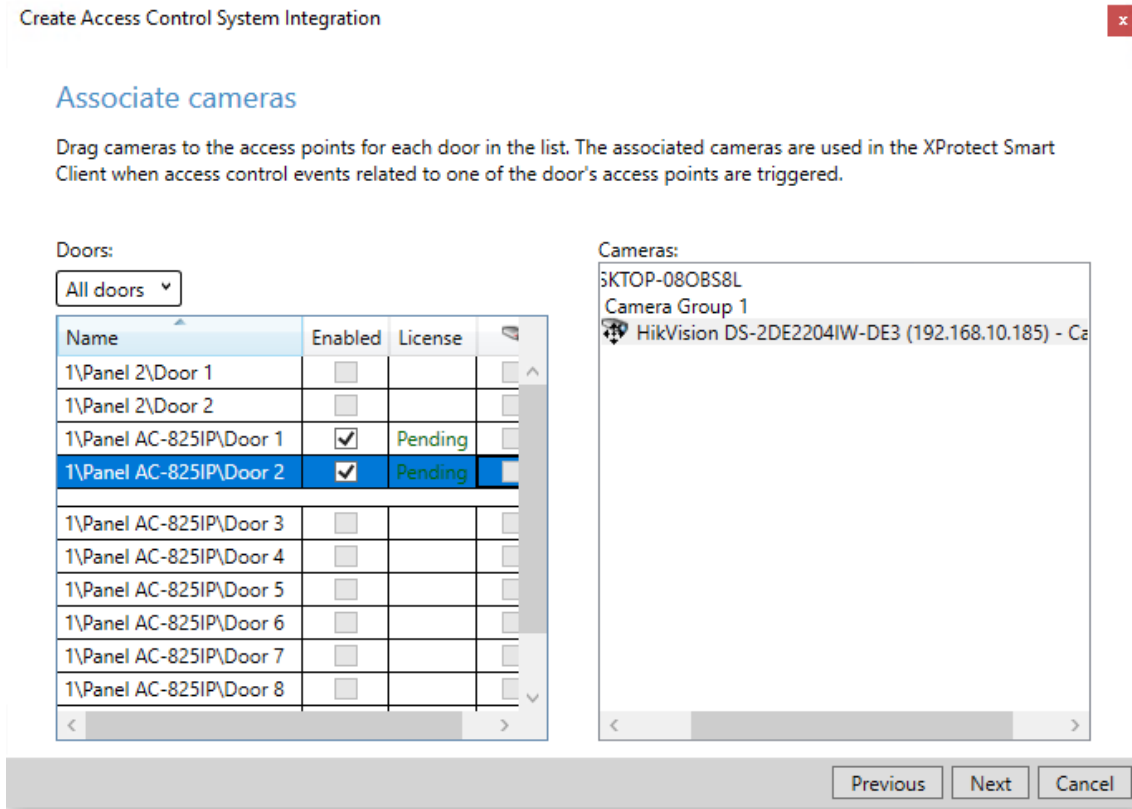


6. Click **Next** and proceed to the next section ([Associating Cameras](#)).

### 3.2. Associating Cameras

To associate cameras to your access control system card readers:

1. Drag cameras to the required access points as described in the **Associate Cameras** window.



2. Click **Next**.

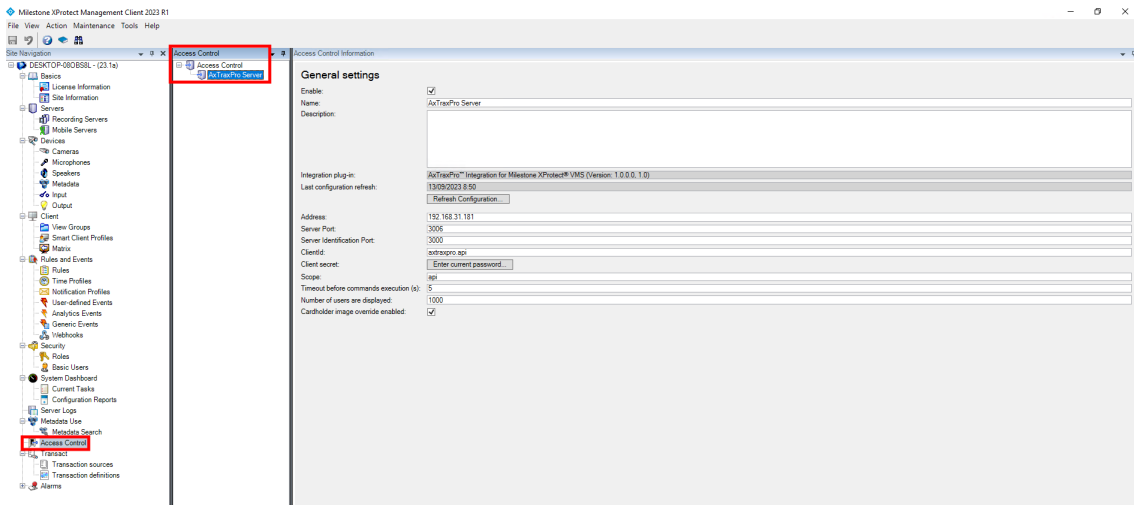

3. Click **Close**.

### 3.3. General Settings

To configure the following recommended settings:

1. In the Milestone XProtect Management Client, click **Access Control** and click **AxTraxPro Server**.



2. Configure the following fields:

- **Client secret** - if you updated the AxTraxPro web-server secret (refer to AxTraxPro Web Client User Guide), update the new secret key here.
- **Timeout before commands execution(s)** – set the timeout for execution commands from the Milestone client to the AxTraxPro Server.
- **Number of users are displayed** – the number of cardholders that will be displayed on each page.

### 3.4. Refreshing the Configuration

If you add or remove elements in AxTraxPro, you must refresh the configuration in the Milestone XProtect Management Client for the changes to take effect.

**To refresh the configuration:**

1. In the AxTraxPro Plugin, click **Properties**, click **General Settings** and click **Refresh Configuration**.



Refreshing the configuration can cause doors to go from licensed to unlicensed and vice versa. It is recommended to click **Doors and Associated Cameras** and review for changes.

### 3.5. Saving Settings

1. If you changed the configuration, a popup to enter the current password appears. If you have not modified the web server secret, click **Enter**.

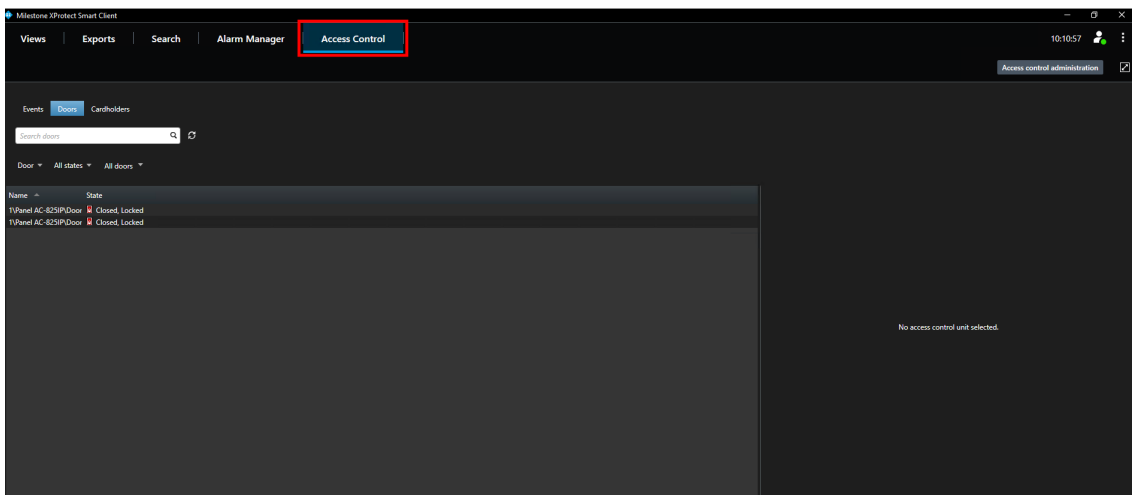
Selecting Enter will also save the current access control configuration.

## 4. Milestone XProtect Client

On the Milestone XProtect Management Client, click **Access Control**.



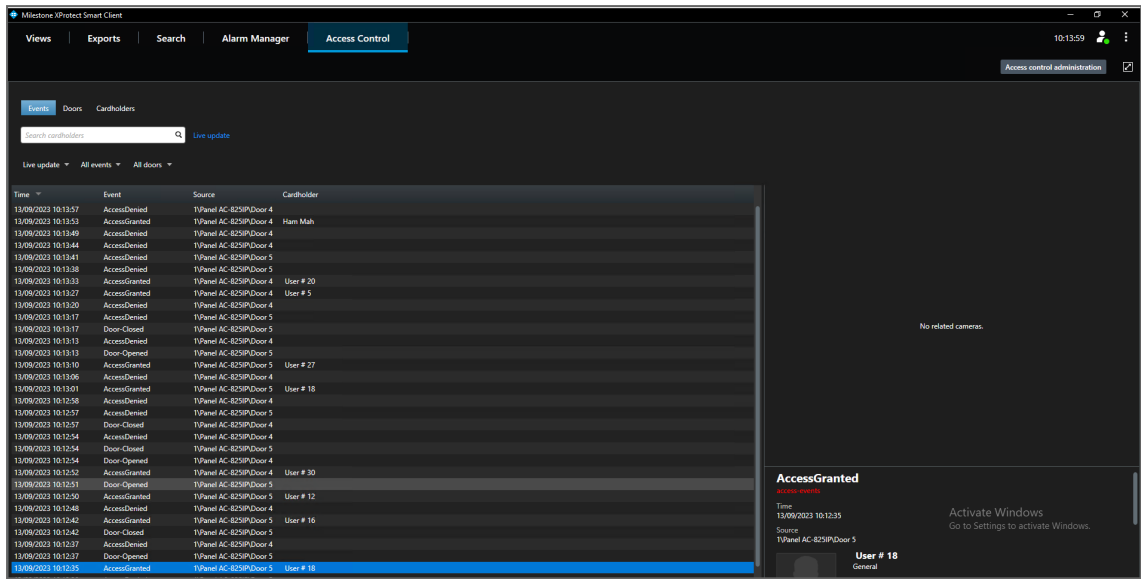
There are three tabs for accessing the following items:

- Events - live events from AxTraxPro
- Doors - list of connected doors from AxTraxPro
- Cardholders - list of cardholders (users) from AxTraxPro

## 4.1. Events

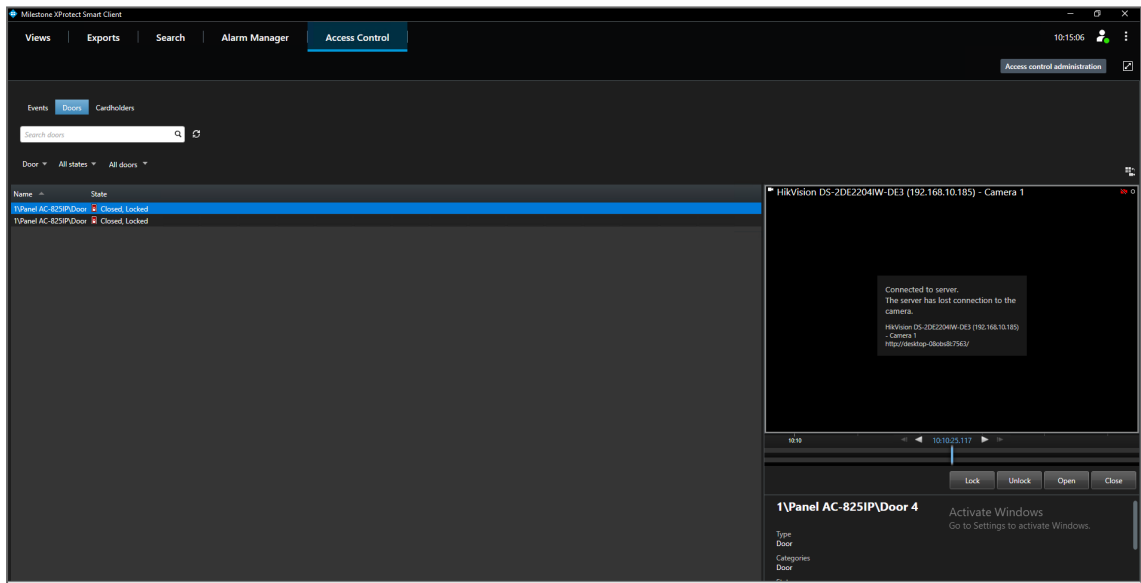
In the events list, you can:

- search events per cardholder using the cardholder search box.
- click an event to load the connected camera
- sort events by event type, selected door or cardholder.



## 4.2. Doors

In the doors list, you can view video streams (if configured) and send commands to a door.

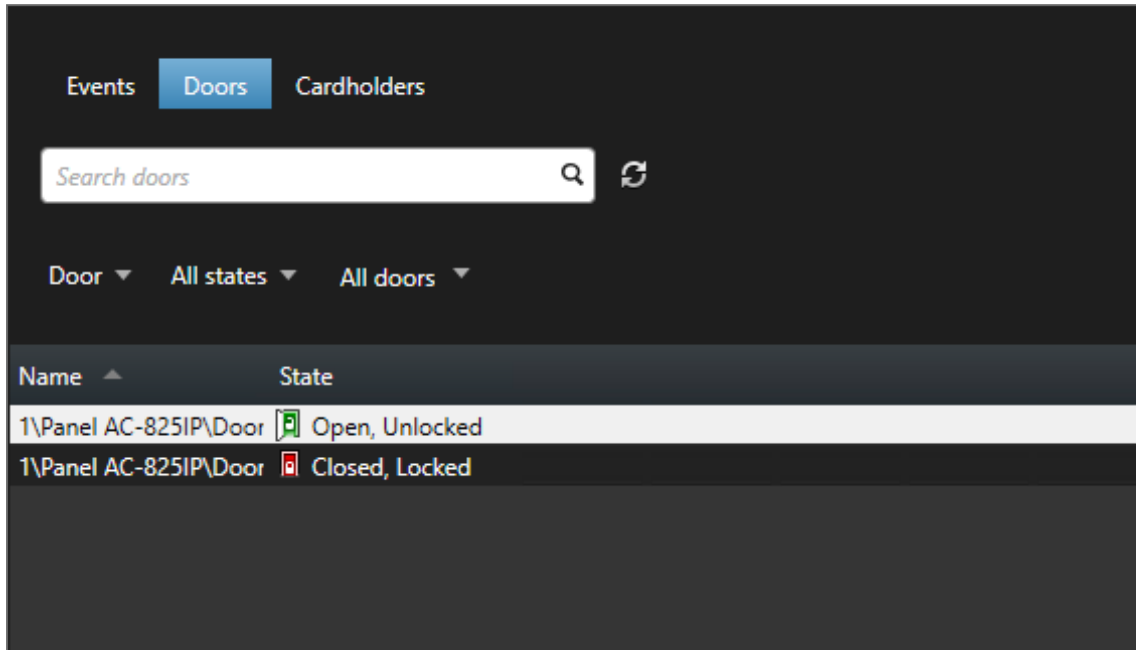


1. Select a door to view live video stream and send the following commands to the door:

- Lock - close the door's output if the door is currently open.
- Unlock – unlock the door permanently.

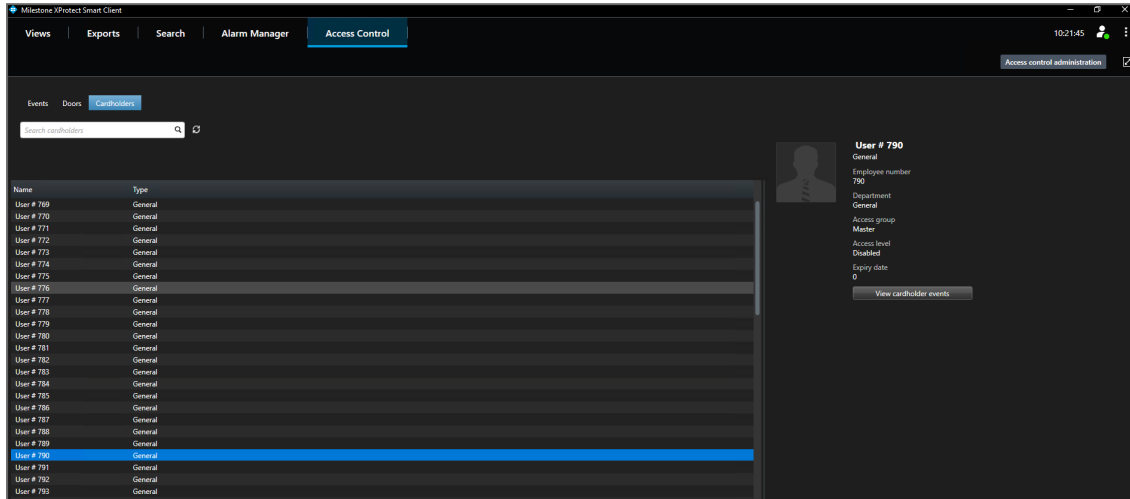
- Open – open the door for 4 seconds.
- Close – close the door's output if the door is currently open.

2. Click the state to change the door status (if the command was created by AxTraxPro Server).



## 4.3. CardHolders

In the Cardholders list, you can view a cardholder's data, image and associated events.



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
